Get Started

1. Determine Your Online Readiness

Learn more about online course requirements and make sure you're prepared to get started. An assessment can be found online at www.minnesotaonline.org

2. Activate Your NHCC Email Account

Email is the official method of communication at NHCC. Be sure to activate your my.nhcc.edu email account at www.nhcc.edu/email

3. Check Computer Requirements

Run a system check to verify that your computer meets the technology requirements for online courses. Access the system check at www.nhcc.edu/computerrequirements

4. Purchase Textbooks

You can purchase your textbooks on-campus or at the NHCC online bookstore. The online bookstore can be found at www.nhcc.edu/bookstore

5. Login to Desire2Learn (D2L)

All online courses are hosted in D2L. Students will have access to login to D2L one week before the start of the semester. Read the *First Time Login Instructions* located on the login page. Access to course pages will begin on the first day of class. Read and become familiar with the information located in the course site on the first day of the class.
